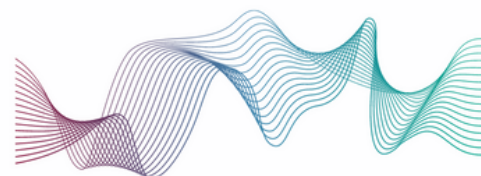


ENHANCING COMMUNICATION SKILLS IN SERIOUS ILLNESS WITH VR: JOIN OUR SURVEY
